LAPD Community-Police Advisory Board Highlights:

- Waze - most folks use it for navigational purposes, but there is a "cop" button within the app that users can select to report police sightings in the area which sends notifications to other Waze users. Why don't residents use the tool to defend their neighborhoods? If you overuse the "drop a cop" feature, you can be marked as an abuser, so to use it sparingly.
- Homicide at Venice and Hauser gas station - both suspects have been arrested.
- On July 1st, 10 patrol cars and one helicopter were dispatched to the Midtown Crossing shopping center after reports of youths believed to be coming from World on Wheels causing general havoc, including throwing firecrackers at passersby and battering customers in the CVS. Previously there were reports of adult patrons ransacking a 7-Eleven store on Pico. The neighborhood prosecutor is preparing a report on the incident.
- Kari Garcia of Miracle Mile and Tammy Rosato of La Brea Hancock continue to build their neighborhood watch programs and are offering a roadmap to C-PAB members wishing to start programs in their neighborhoods.
