TNP Survey --

CS brought audience up to speed on the TNP Survey and gave a brief overview of the current situation. Senate Bill 50, seeking to eliminate single family zoning in transit hubs. CS noted that the most important thing is the number of responses to the survey so that the City sees that our neighborhood is active and cares.

DB feels there is a strong perspective in the responses to the survey, CS noted that this is the suggestion of the Land Use Committee, and that survey respondents can pick and choose the responses.

Bryan encouraged inter-neighborhood communications, CS informed him that SySq has been involved with surrounding neighborhoods. Larry suggested to change "wrong" to "unfavorable"

DB would like to add "The suggestions contained herein from the LUC are focused on preserving the SySq neighborhood as much as it is. Limited internal development and promoting use of public transportation over vehicular ownership."
